ATHLETIC TRAINING

Football

- 30 gallons of water (in Powerade coolers), 4 sleeves of cups, 50 gallons of ice, one chest of injury ice with bags, and a biohazardous waste receptacle will be provided on the visiting team sideline.
- 10 gallons of water and 2 sleeve of cups will be provided outside the lockerroom entrance.
- A Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) will be present at all games.
- A team physician will be present at all games. They will be located on the home sideline during competition.
- Emergency Medical Services will be present at all games.
- A satellite Athletic Training Room is located near the visitors' locker room. Ice, heat packs, taping and treatment tables, and a biohazardous waste receptacle are also available in this area.
- Requests for additional supplies and or equipment should be directed to the Head Athletic Trainer. Every attempt will be made to comply with all such requests.

Men's & Women's Soccer

- Ice water, cups, and a cooler of injury ice and bags will be provided on each bench. Vacuum splints and a biohazardous waste receptacle will be also available at the field.
- Towels will be provided upon request.
- A Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) will be present at all games.
- EMS & our team physicians/orthopaedists will be on-call.
- If an ATC cannot travel with your team, please send a letter outlining any treatments required by your athletes.
- Ice, heat packs, whirlpools, ultrasound, muscle stim units, and taping tables are available in the Athletic Training Room in Pioneer Arena, which will open two hours prior to game time.
- A satellite Athletic Training Room is located near the visitors' locker room. Ice, heat packs, and taping tables are located in this room.

Volleyball & Basketball

- Ice water, cups, and a cooler of injury ice and bags will be provided on each bench. Vacuum splints, a biohazardous waste receptacle, and blood spill clean-up kit will be also available at the court.
- Towels will be provided upon request.
- A Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) will be present at all games.
- EMS & our team physicians/orthopaedists will be on-call.
- If an ATC cannot travel with your team, please send a letter outlining any treatments required by your athletes.
- Ice, heat packs, whirlpools, ultrasound, muscle stim units, and taping tables are available in the Athletic Training Room in Pioneer Arena, which will open two hours prior to game time.

Baseball & Softball

- Ice water, cups, and a cooler of injury ice and bags will be provided on each bench. Vacuum splints and a biohazardous waste receptacle will be also available at the field.
- Towels will be provided upon request.
- A Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) will be present at all games.
- EMS & our team physicians/orthopaedists will be on-call.
- If an ATC cannot travel with your team, please send a letter outlining any treatments required by your athletes.
- Ice, heat packs, whirlpools, ultrasound, muscle stim units, and taping tables are available in the Athletic Training Room in Pioneer Arena, which will open two hours prior to game time.

ATHLETIC TRAINING

Men's & Women's Tennis

- Water and cups will be provided on each court. Ice with bags, vacuum splints and a biohazardous waste receptacle will be also available at the court area.
- Towels will be provided upon request.
- A Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) will be present at all matches.
- EMS & our team physicians/orthopaedists will be on-call.
- If an ATC cannot travel with your team, please send a letter outlining any treatments required by your athletes.
- Ice, heat packs, whirlpools, ultrasound, muscle stim units, and taping tables are available in the Athletic Training Room in Pioneer Arena, which will open two hours prior to the match.

Cross Country

- Ice water, Powerade, cups, and a cooler of injury ice and bags will be provided at the start/finish line tent. Vacuum splints and a biohazardous waste receptacle will be also available at the start/finish line.
- A Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) will be present at all races. Before and after the race, this individual will be located in the start/finish line tent. During the race, he/she will be surveying the course on a golf cart.
- EMS & our team physicians/orthopaedists will be on-call.
- If an ATC cannot travel with your team, please send a letter outlining any treatments required by your athletes.
- Ice, heat packs, whirlpools, ultrasound, muscle stim units, and taping tables are available in the Athletic Training Room in Alpine Arena, which will open two hours prior to race time.

Golf

- Bottled water will be provided on the 10th tee box.
- A Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) will be present at the course. This individual will be located in the clubhouse before competition and on the 10th tee box during competition
- EMS & our team physicians/orthopaedists will be on-call.
- Please contact the Head Athletic Trainer with any treatments required by your athletes. Every effort will be made to accommodate your athletes at the golf course.

DIRECTIONS

From ASHEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA (from the Southeast)

Travel west on I-26 towards Johnson City; Take Exit 37 (old exit 18 - Jonesborough/Erwin) and turn left onto TN 81/TN 107 West; Travel 6.5 miles and turn left onto TN 107 West (follow Greenville sign); Travel 16 miles and turn left at Tusculum College sign; Go 1 mile and turn left into main campus on Shiloh Rd.

From KNOXVILLE, TENNESSEE

Travel east on I-40 and take I-81 North towards Bristol. Take Exit 23 (Greenville/Bulls Gap) and turn right onto US 11E N; Travel 16 miles. (Note: when reaching Greenville city limits, continue on US 11E North By-Pass towards Jonesborough/Johnson City); turn right onto Erwin Hwy (McDonald's on the corner). Travel 1 mile and turn right into main campus on Shiloh Rd.

From BRISTOL, TENNESSEE/VIRGINIA

Travel south on I-81; Take Exit 57A to I-26 East (towards Johnson City); Travel 7.9 miles to Exit 38 (Jonesborough - Boones Creek Rd.). Turn right onto 354 South and go 5.9 miles to US 11E South; Travel 18.1 miles and turn left at TN 107 East (follow Tusculum College signs); Make an immediate right onto Sam Doak Drive and go 0.7 miles; Turn left onto main campus on Shiloh Rd.

FOOTBALL/SOCCER

MEDIA PARKING: Turn left after passing Katherine Hall. **TEAM BUSES:** Go past Nichols Tennis Complex and turn left into drive; Turn left towards Indoor Practice Facility to circle drive by South entrance of Pioneer Field.

BASKETBALL/VOLLEYBALL

MEDIA PARKING: Turn right after passing Katherine Hall, park in parking lot on the immediate left. **TEAM BUSES:** Turn right after passing Katherine Hall, Pioneer Arena will be on the left. After dropping off players and personnel, buses may park by the Indoor Practice Facility.

BASEBALL

MEDIA PARKING/SPECTATORS: Turn left after passing Katherine Hall. Pioneer Park is located just beyond the football stadium on the right. **TEAM BUSES:** Go past the Nichols Tennis Complex and turn left towards upper practice fields. Go up the hill until drive opens up into the parking lot. Buses are asked to drop off teams, which will walk down the sidewalk and enter the stadium at the players entrance gate on the side (no spikes please). **SPECTATORS MUST ENTER THROUGH MAIN STADIUM ENTRANCE.**

SOFTBALL

Coming from Andrew Johnson Hwy. (US 11E)

Travel approx. 2 miles, passing the college on your right. Turn right onto Old Erwin Hwy. Go one block and turn right onto Pleasant View Drive (the widest street in Greenville - used to be a runway for the old airport). Edmonds Field is at the end of the street. **BUSES:** Please park on Pleasant View Drive at the end of the street on the right hand side (do not park in gravel parking lot behind home plate).

Coming from Hwy. 107

Turn left at Tusculum College sign (Erwin Hwy). Travel approx. 1/2 mile and turn left onto Pleasant View Drive (the widest street in Greenville - used to be a runway for the old airport). Edmonds Field is at the end of the street. **BUSES:** Please park on Pleasant View Drive at the end of the street on the right hand side (do not park in gravel parking lot behind home plate).

TENNIS

TEAM BUSES: Turn right after passing Katherine Hall, and park in the parking lot adjacent to Pioneer Arena and the Niswonger Student Commons. The Roger M. Nichols Tennis Complex is across the street. Please use caution when crossing Shiloh Rd.

CROSS COUNTRY

(GREENE VALLEY DEVELOPMENT CENTER)

Coming from Andrew Johnson Hwy.

Stay on Andrew Johnson Hwy., and travel two miles from the Wal-Mart intersection. Greene Valley Development Center will be on your right.

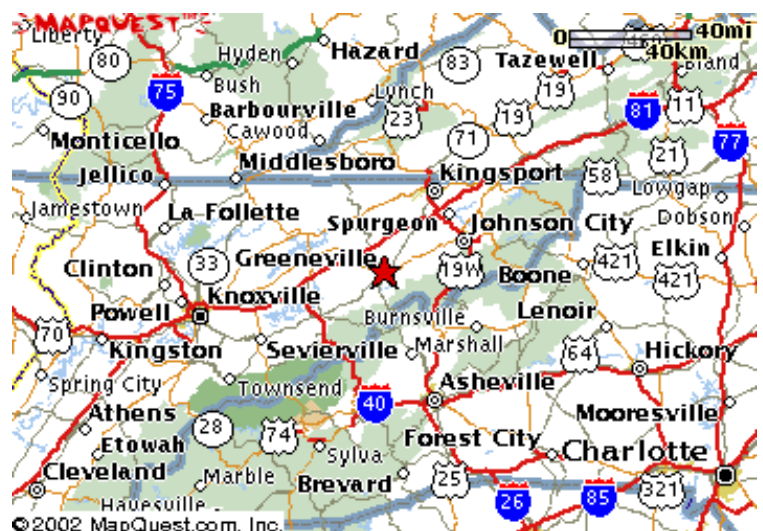
Coming from Hwy. 107

Continue on Hwy. 107 and turn right at US 11-E (Andrew Johnson Hwy.). Go 0.3 miles and the Greene Valley Development Center will be on your right.

LINK HILLS COUNTRY CLUB

From Hotels (US 11E - Andrew Johnson Hwy.)

Take US 11E South and follow signs to TN Hwy 70 South. Stay on 70 South for approximately 6 miles until you see the Campground Church of God on your right. Turn left on the next street (Allens Bridge Road). Travel 1.5 miles and Link Hills Country Club will be on your left. Average travel time to from hotels to course is 20-25 minutes.

TUSCULUM COLLEGE PET POLICY

Pets are not allowed at Tusculum College home athletic events. Only service animals or other pre-approved animals are allowed at athletic venues. Please inform your student-athletes, parents and fans who may be traveling to Greeneville of this policy. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

ATHLETIC MEDIA RELATIONS

The Tusculum College Athletic Media Relations Office is responsible for all sports information for the Pioneer Athletic Department and the 14 intercollegiate sport teams the College sponsors.

Press Areas: (Football, Basketball & Baseball Only): Allocated space in the press areas of Pioneer Field (football) and Pioneer Arena (basketball), will be automatically reserved for coaches, film crew, radio network and SID; however, a press pass will still be required to gain access to the press area. Press passes will be mailed prior to the event.

Sideline Passes: (Football Only): All sideline personnel, except for players in uniform, are required to display a sideline pass. This includes coaches, players not in uniform, managers, trainers, team physicians and photographers. Direct all additional requests to Dom Donnelly at (423) 636-7326.

Press Area Services: Press Guides, game programs, , (FB only - half, final, individual, defensive) and play-by-play will be provided. Food & drinks will also be available (Football & Basketball Only) for all media and game staff.

Radio Broadcasts: The visiting SID is asked to contact Dom Donnelly regarding plans to broadcast at least two weeks in advance.

Scouts: Professional scouts are asked to contact Dom Donnelly to obtain press passes in advance. Opposing teams wishing to scout Tusculum teams or the opposition are free to do so, but from the seating areas only. Opposing teams and their coaches who are scouting the event are not permitted in the press box or press row areas (this includes soccer matches).

Film Crews/Video Arrangements: Visiting film crews are located in the following areas:

Football/Soccer - Second floor press box film area.

Basketball & Volleyball - Filming platform above East grandstands across from press row. Filming from the end zone patio area is allowed for volleyball matches ONLY.

Postgame Media Requests: The Tusculum College Athletic Media Relations Office will handle all postgame media requests. The final result of athletic contests will be distributed to media outlets. We ask that the visiting SID provide a media list with telephone, fax numbers and email addresses, prior to the event. Updated statistics will be provided to visiting sports information directors and coaches during half-time and a press release with final statistical summary will be sent as a part of the postgame report.
